VISION


To assist individuals and families with addiction related problems and encourage healthier lifestyles.

OUR PROGRAM

- A Our program offers a comprehensive approach to substance abuse recovery in a group setting. It aims to foster an understanding of addiction, provide a sense of direction with external resources, and enhance self-awareness, self-esteem, self-worth, and spirituality. Information is shared through psychoeducational groups, speakers, and/or videos that cover the addiction process, initial recovery steps, and treatment preparation.
- While at Foothills, clients have access to the Program Manager and Program Assistants for one-on-one support, referral to further treatment, and assistance with issues involved with recovery. We provide harm reduction education while engaging clients to co-develop safety plans and next steps should their preferred treatment plan no longer meet their needs and goals. The Centre emphasizes personalized support throughout the recovery journey, including discharge planning, relapse prevention (This service is for individuals who have had some length of sobriety or non-use but are feeling vulnerable to relapse, with a two or three-day stay often sufficing to refocus them on recovery), and transition support for those without a safe space post-detox.
- The Program Manager works in close contact with other service providers to ensure client needs are being met. Clients may also utilize our services for a mandatory five day stay before treatment. Support services are also available on an out-patient basis, past clients or community members may attend group lectures upon request.
- * We also provide by appointment, support and information to family members going through a crisis within their family unit.
